Section 1. SHORT TITLE. Leash Law for Mt. Upton and adjacent area

REGULATIONS. It shall be unlawful for any person to allow any dog owned by said person to leave the premises of the owner of said dog unless the dog is restricted by a leash or lead rope of a maximum length of no more than ten (10) feet or said dog is under the control of a person competent and able to manage and control such animal. The purpose of this law is to restrict and stop the running at large of dogs in the area covered by this leash law as hereinafter described. The area in which this law shall be in effect shall be the entire Water District in the Hamlet of Mt. Upton, as follows: bordered on the south by the Mt. Upton Elementary School; bordered on the east by the Unadilla River; bordered on the north by the northerly edge of the Water District; bordered on the west by the old railroad bed which shall run northerly to the point where it crosses Route 8, then Route 8 becomes the westerly boundary line continuing north to the Town Line. Any such animal which is observed running at large in violation of this local law may be seized by the dog warden of the Town of Guilford or by any peace officer and may be restrained. The owner of such animal shall have the right to redeem the animal upon payment of the required fees and in the absence of any redemption of the animal by a person claiming to be its owner, any animal seized under the provisions of this local law may be disposed of after a period of seven (7) days. Such seizure and disposal shall be governed by the provisions of the Agricultural and Markets Law of the State of New York.

Section 3. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES. Any person who violates the provisions of this local law shall be subject to punishment by a fine not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each such violation.
