Section 1. SHORT TITLE. Swimming Regulations Law of the Town of Guilford.

Section 2. REGULATIONS. It shall be unlawful for any person to swim in the Town of Guilford swimming area on Guilford Lake unless a certified life guard is present. Hours of swimming and hours of the life guard being present will be posted for the public's information.

Section 3. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES. Any person who violates the provisions of this local law shall be subject to punishment by a fine not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).



RESOLVED, that it shall be unlawful for any person to swim in the Town of Guilford swimming area on Guilford Lake unless a certified life guard is present. Hours of swimming and hours of the life being present will be posted for the public's information. Any violation of this Town Law shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00)
