Guilford, New York.

(ww) Old Chenango County Road #43 in the vicinity of East Guilford,
New York for its entire distance.

(xx) Hohreiter Road (Guilford Town Road #13) from Chenango County Road
#38 to Guilford Town Road #25.

(yy) The entire distance of East Guilford Cemetary Road (Guilford Town
Road #42).

SECTION 2-EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall be effective upon compliance with the filing
provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law, except that no snowmobile shall be
operated or driven under the authority hereof, until such time as appropriate
traffic and snowmobile control signs or devices are erected in compliance with
the rules and regulationof the New York State Department of Transportation and
or the Office of Park and Recreation.




